Habitat for Humanity - May & June

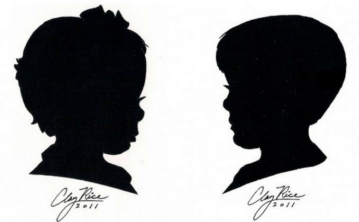
